### Sixth Form Dress Guidance

- The sixth form is a place of work and standards of dress and appearance should reflect this.
- All members of the sixth form act as both ambassadors for the school within the local community and important and influential role models for students in years 7 – 11.
- Our corporate responsibility for Health & Safety means that certain clothing is unsuitable for a school environment.

### Example dress standards

Appropriate cultural dress	
Outdoor coats must be removed when inside the School building	



### **Unacceptable dress/appearance**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Torn, dirty or scruffy clothes</li><li>• Shorts</li><li>• High heeled shoes /flip-flops</li><li>• Bandannas, hoods, caps or hats</li><li>• Items of clothing which show midriiffs and/or underwear</li><li>• Other revealing clothing</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Items of clothing/accessories bearing offensive slogans or messages</li><li>• Visible tattoos/body art</li><li>• Headphones, IPods/MP3 players or similar media devices (these may be used in the sixth form common room as well as mobile phones)</li></ul>
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The school site, including the area to the front of the school, is designated as a no smoking environment.

It is beyond the scope of this code to provide guidance on every eventuality. In the event of queries, the Director of Sixth Form will act as the arbiter.
